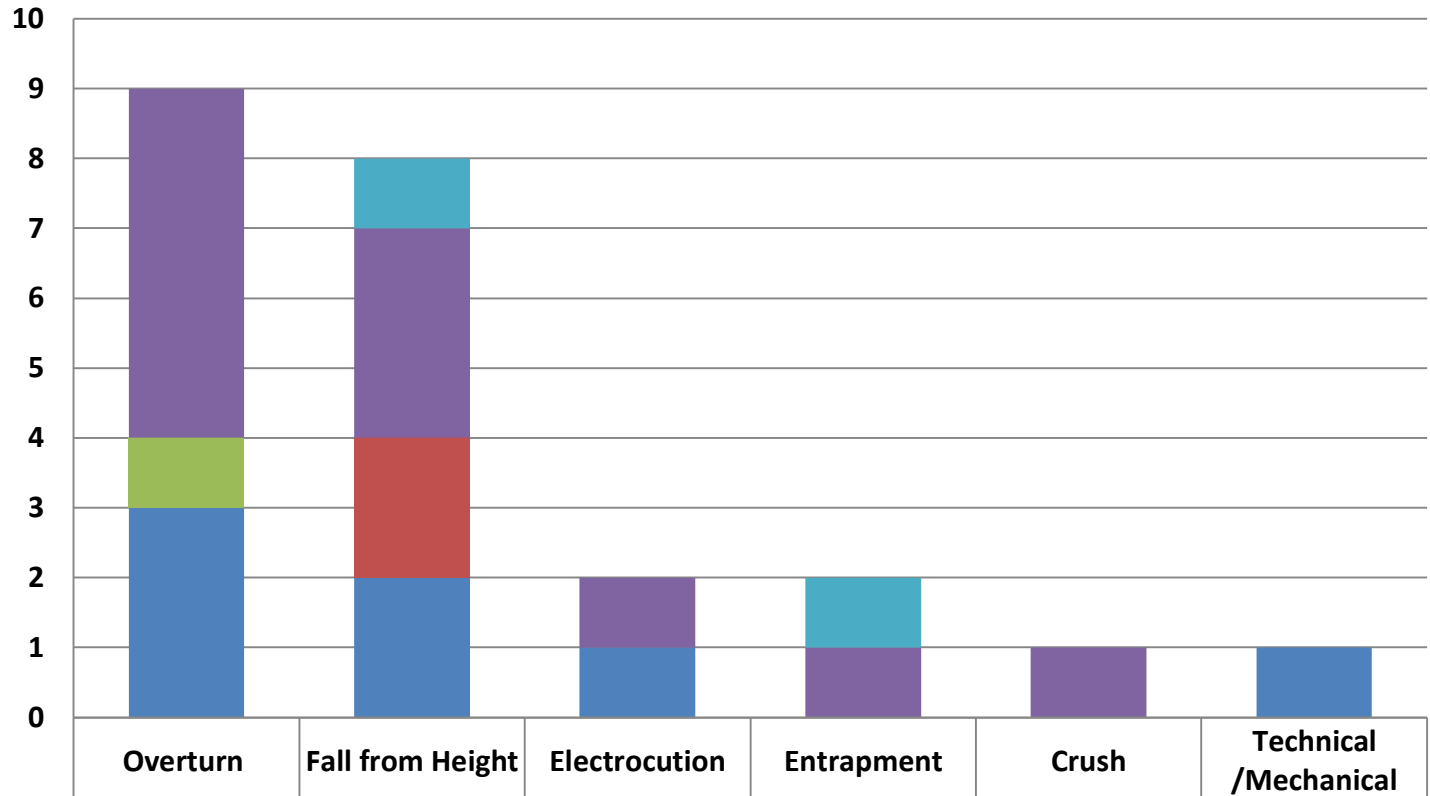

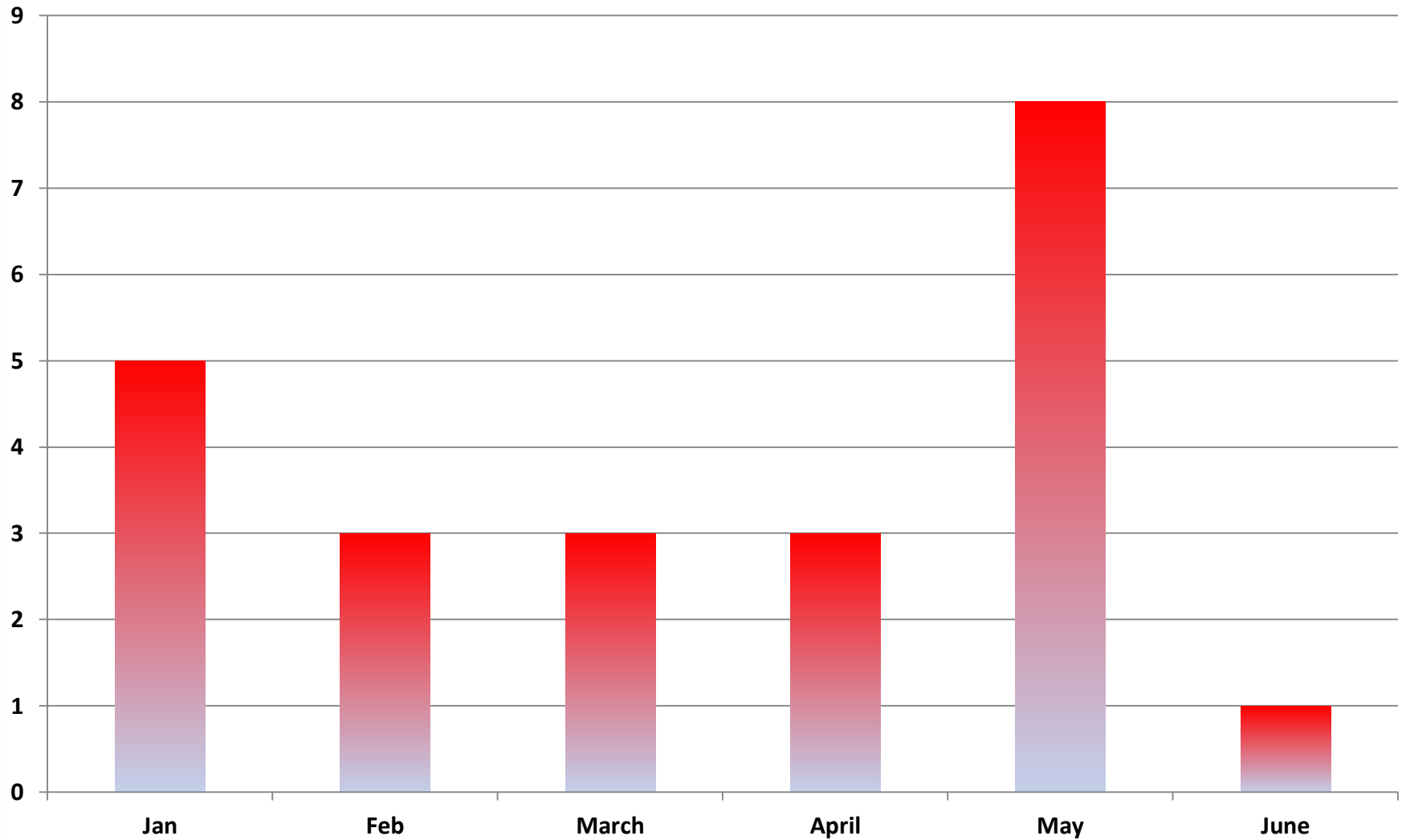

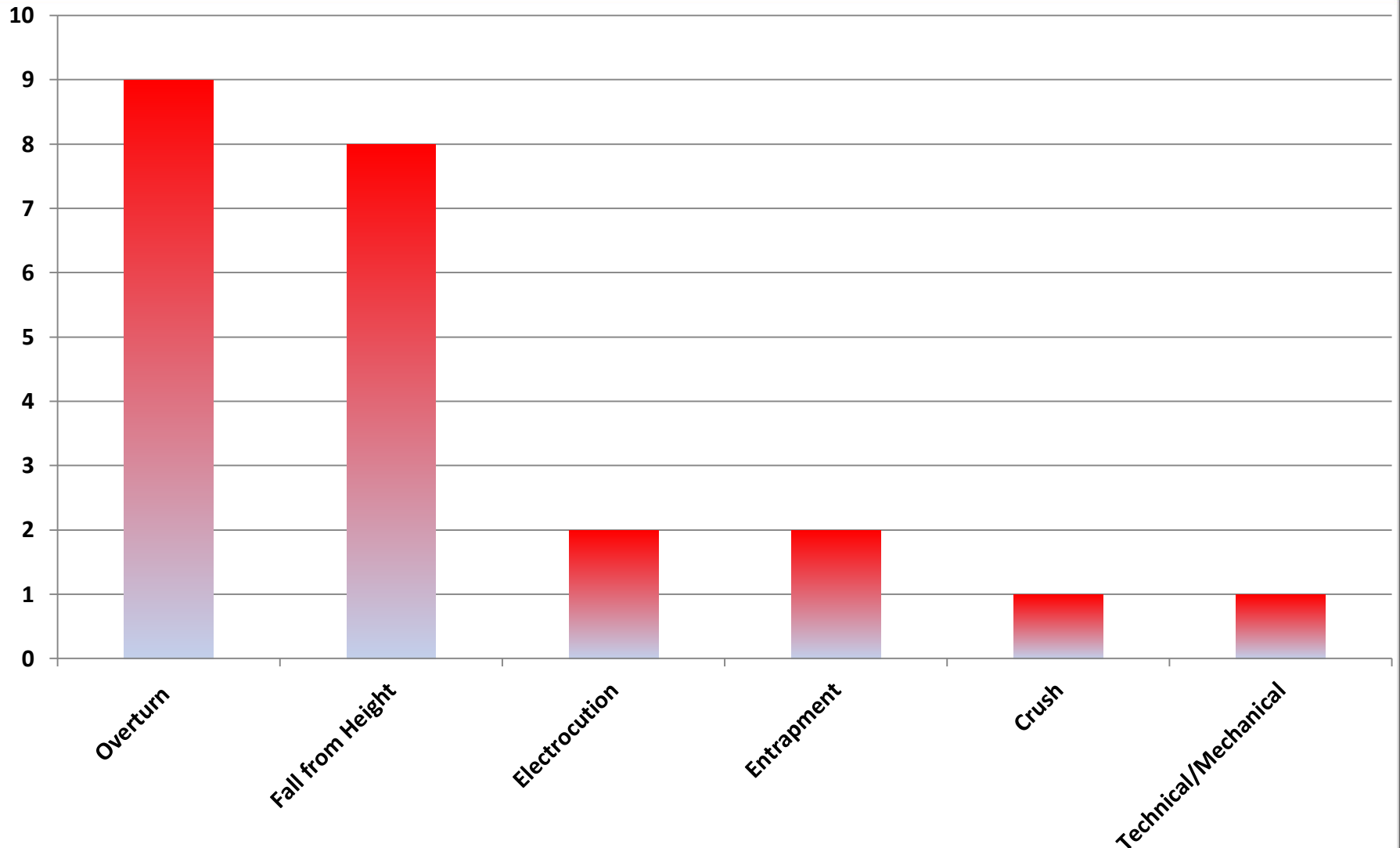

2014 Half year fatal data by causation



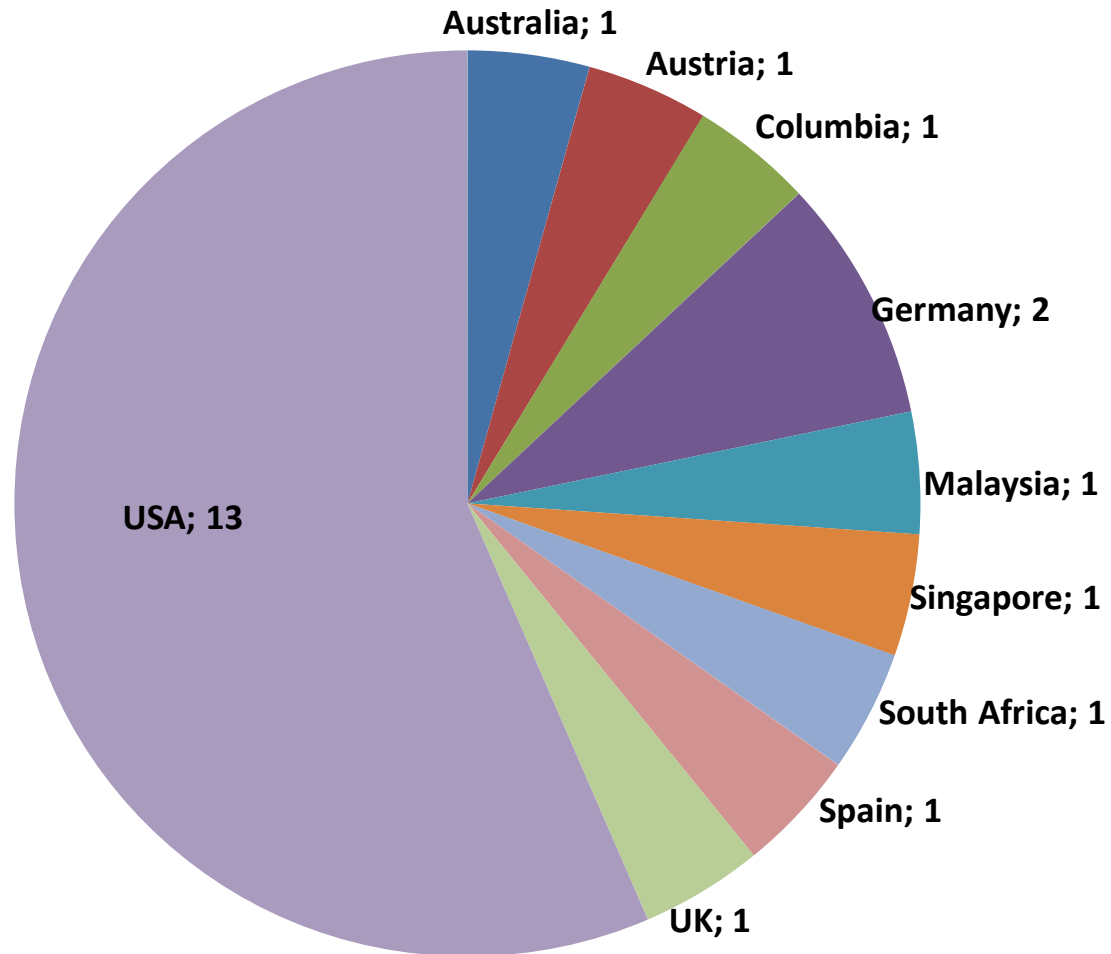

2014 Half year fatal data by Country



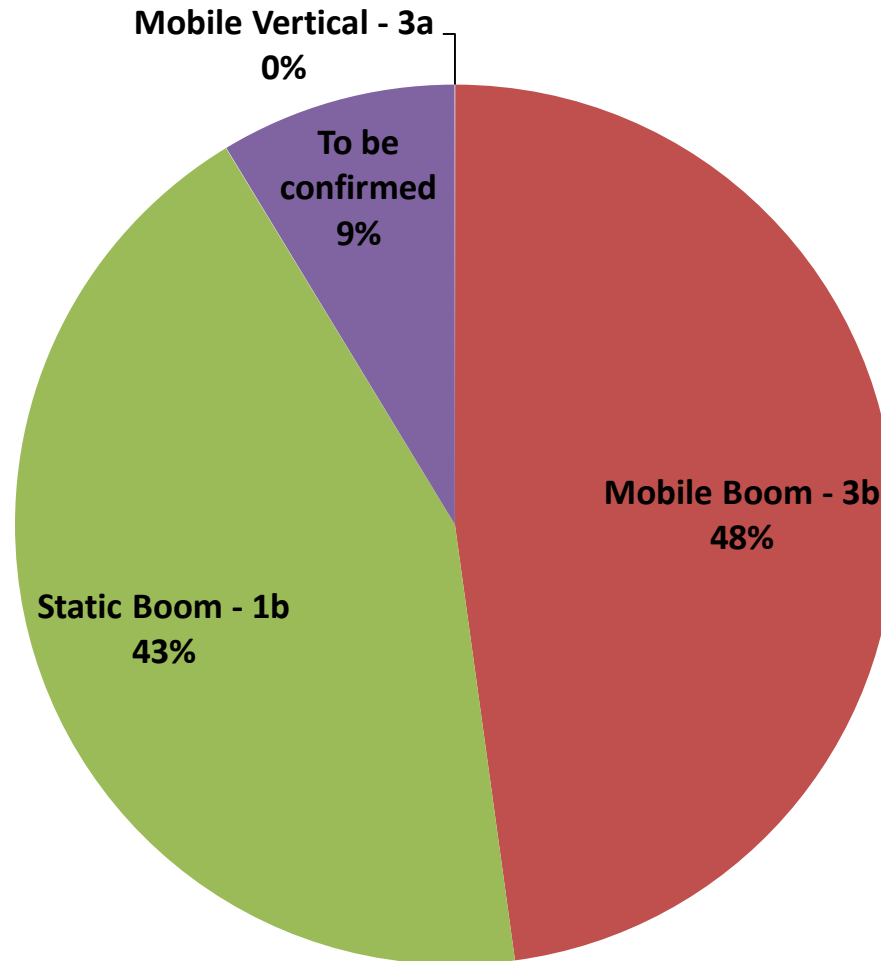

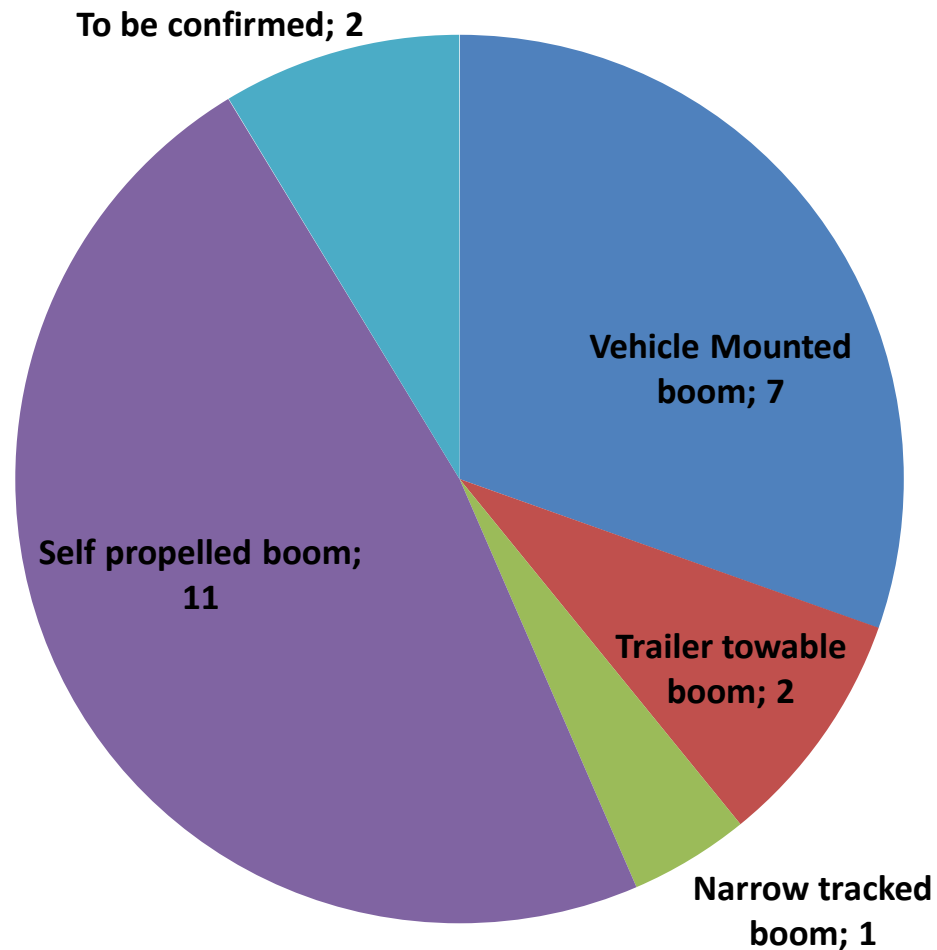
